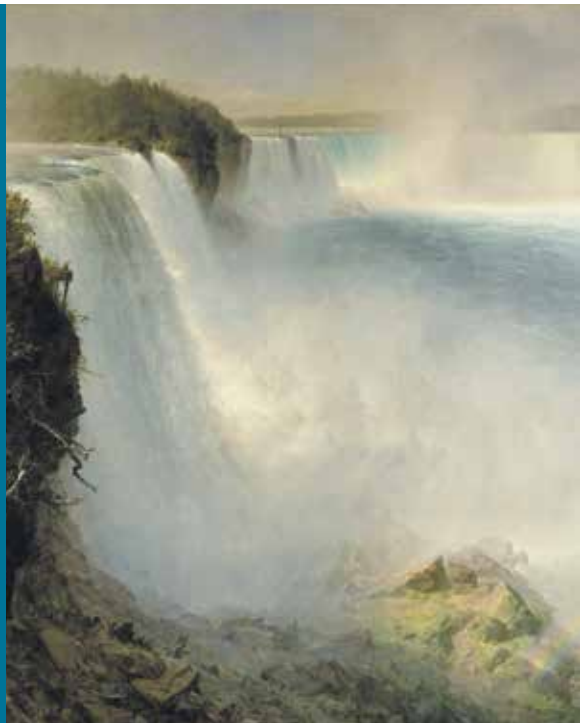

# THE WALLACE AWARDS FOR HERITAGE, ARTS & CULTURE

## Background

The American-Scottish Foundation introduced the Wallace Award in 1970 to recognize the extraordinary diversity of contribution that Scots have made to the world - and, in particular, to recognize one or more living citizens or residents of the United States of Scottish descent for their individual contributions to the well-being of this country. The Foundation has now expanded the Award's reach to include either Scots or Americans who have made an important contribution to American/Scottish relationships.

The evening allows the ASF to further its mission of strengthening ties between Scotland and the United States and benefits the ongoing work of the Foundation through the pursuit of contemporary social, cultural, educational and business activities.

## Purposes

- To recognize living citizens or residents of the United States or Canada of Scottish descent for outstanding achievement or significant contribution in their field of endeavor.
- To recognize "in memoriam" citizens or residents of the United States or Canada of Scottish descent for outstanding achievement or significant contribution in their field of endeavor.
- To recognize living Scots and Americans for their contribution to Scottish-American relationships.

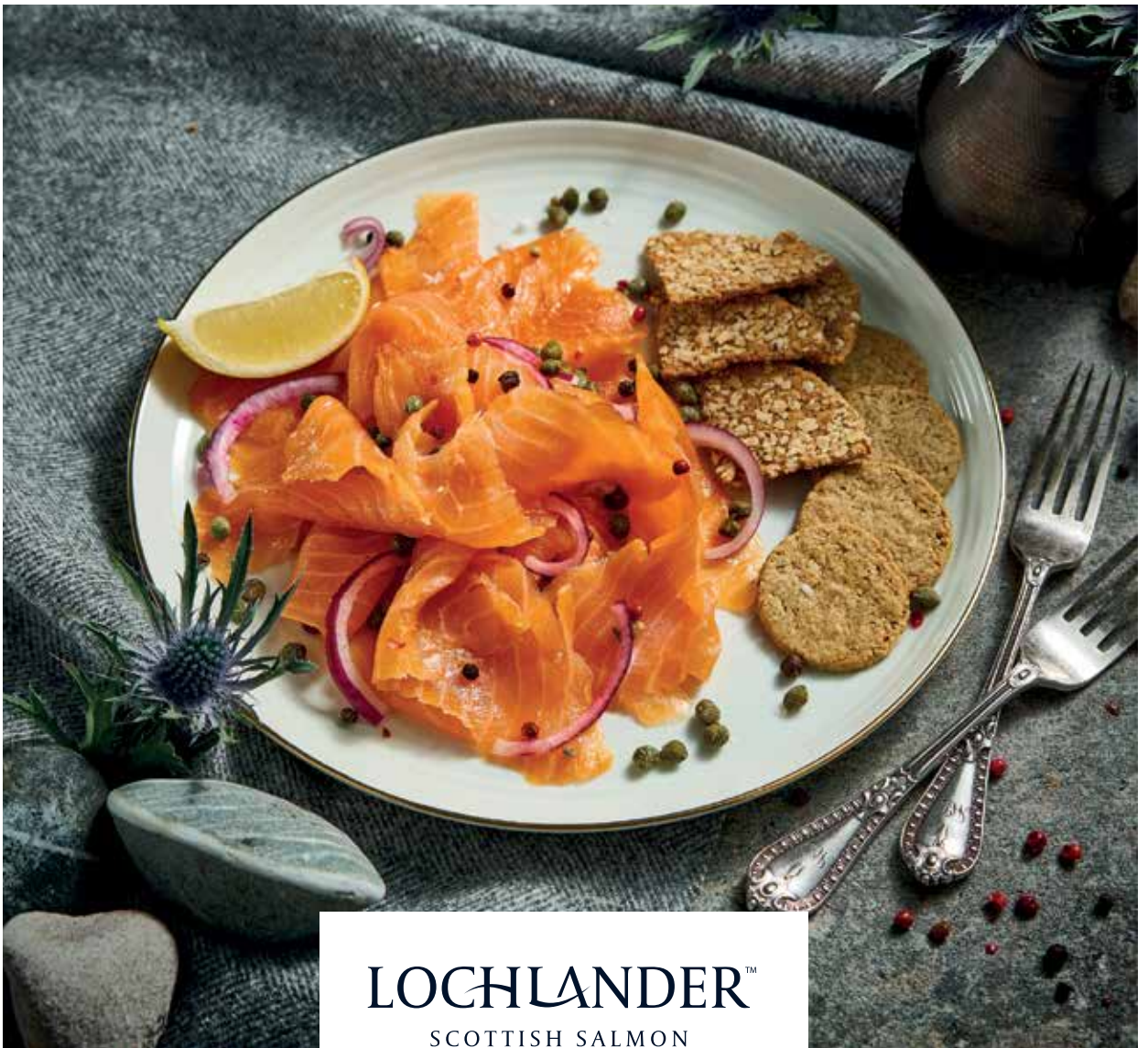

For those of us who have been fortunate enough to receive the coveted Wallace Award it is a great pleasure to be asked to extend a warm welcome to the recipients this evening: The Lord Lyon King of Arms, Dr Joseph Morrow and A. Wright Post Palmer; and also to Scott Gilmour and Claire McKenzie of Noisemaker who will be collecting the Young Scot Wallace Award.

I have known Joe Morrow for many years and endorse the decision of your awards committee to honour him for his singular contribution to promoting Heraldry and for maintaining the authority of the Lyon Court as an influential and deeply respected institution in Scotland and widely overseas. I have lost count of the number of people I have met over the years who have achieved the ambition of a lifetime by matriculating their Coat of Arms at the Lyon Court and have found the whole experience to be transformative for them - and for their families - and a truly unique legacy to pass on to future generations.

So much of the underlying value of our national story is an amalgam of family histories instantly identifiable by the vivid imagery of Heraldry such as the heart that adorns your Coat of Arms, the heart of King Robert the Bruce borne so heroically by Sir James Douglas, the ancestor of your Patron, The Duke of Hamilton. For Heraldry is the storehouse of identity and there is no doubt that Scotland has benefitted hugely from the care and dedication that Dr Morrow and his colleagues at the Lyon Court have contributed to its preservation and revitalisation.

## The Wallace Award



### **Dr Joseph John Morrow CVO CBE KC FRSE The Rt Hon Lord Lyon King of Arms**

**Wallace Award recipient for his leadership of the Lyon Court  
and its role in Scotland today.**

As Lord Lyon, Dr Morrow is responsible for state ceremonial in Scotland and took part in the Coronation of King Charles III and Queen Camilla in 2023. He also designed and delivered the Service of Thanksgiving for the presentation of the Royal Honours of Scotland, at which the Crown, Sceptre and Sword of Scotland were presented to the King in St Giles' Cathedral in Edinburgh.

Professionally, Dr Morrow is a member of the Faculty of Advocates and became a Queen's Counsel (QC) in 2015 (now King's Counsel (KC)). He held many judicial including as President of the Mental Health Tribunal for Scotland (2008–2019), as Her Majesty's Commissioner for Mental Welfare for Scotland (1998–2006), and as President of the Additional Support Needs Tribunal for Scotland (2010–2014). In addition, he served as a Member of the Judicial Council for Scotland for a four year period and on numerous national boards within Scotland.

### A. Wright Post Palmer

**Wallace award recipient for his outstanding contribution  
in the preservation of history, arts and culture.**

A. Wright Post Palmer is the recipient of the 2025 Wallace Award in recognition of his outstanding charitable work in regard to New York's history, arts, culture, and education

Wright is a direct descendant of early Scottish, Dutch, and British settlers which includes descent from the Beekman/Livingston family—early founders of New Amsterdam (New York City) in the 17th century—and to the Lindsay (Sanders) family of Scottish descent, among the founders of Albany and Schenectady, New York, also in the 17th century.

Wright became President and CEO of Beekman Estates in 1980, a position he held for nearly half a century, and today continues to serve as Chairman of the Board, overseeing the stewardship of one of America's oldest family-owned real estate corporations.

In 2012, Scot Gilmour and Claire McKenzie formed the musical theatre writing partnership Noisemaker while at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland in Glasgow. Their first show, Forest Boy, premiered at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in 2013 and subsequently went on to the New York Musical Festival in 2016. Subsequently, Noisemaker have written, developed and produced over twenty new works across the UK, the US and internationally.

Using music, song, humour and heart, the pair seek to tell stories that bring people together to connect, and sometimes challenge, our sense of humanity.
